

T2-0097-UHB BIC in Settlement Bank Account Group (SBAG)

- Primarly concerns: Visibility/retrievability of static data for ancillary systems in CRDM
 - Present: Ancillary systems can see the account numbers of their settlement banks but not the Account BICs
 - Account BICs are necessary for the AS to create the relevant ancillary system messages for initiating transactions (pain.998)
 - Implementation/adaption of a query for ancillary systems to retrieve all relevant information from their settlement banks in A2A (incl. Account BICs)
 - Query via acmt.025 in CRDM (answer: acmt.026)
 - SBAG memberships in CRDM currently can be changed with effect from the same business day
 - Due to the once-evening data propagation, such changes only become active on the next business day in RTGS
 - In future: change of SBAGs possible on the next business day at the earliest



T2-0097-UHB BIC in Settlement Bank Account Group (SBAG)

- **Side effect:** in future, additional group objects in CRDM can only be changed with effect from the next business day:
 - Account Monitoring Group¹
 - Billing Group²
 - Liquidity Transfer Group³
 - Banking Group (only relevant for central banks)

¹ For liquidity monitoring purposes; Maintenance by the account holder himself

² Creation of a group of RTGS-DCAs to benefit from degressive price structure (requirement: same Banking Group); Maintenance by NCB upon request of participant

³ For the exchange of liquidity within settlement services; Maintenance by NCB upon request of participant

Release content and impact



T2-0114-URD Prevent four-eye bypass with DN check

- <u>Starting point:</u>
 - In CRDM, a "certificate distinguished name" (CDN) can be linked to several users
 - T2 (CLM and RTGS) checks the 4-eye principle at user level
 - As a result, this check could currently be bypassed if two users are created for one person with the same CDN (under the same party)
- <u>Changes:</u>
 - In future, **CLM and RTGS task queue** will only accept orders where two different CDNs have a) created and b) approved the task/order
 - The existing requirement that creation and approval must be carried out by two different users remains in place

<u>Caution:</u> In a scenario in which a person under a party accesses CLM and RGTS via two NSPs (and therefore with different CDNs), a link to one and the same user is required to guarantee the four-eye principle.

Regression Testing and Re-Test of PBIs

- Implementation of regression tests based on mandatory test cases and testing of individual important production processes are <u>recommended</u>
- Regarding PBIs (problem tickets) opened by customers, which are fixed with T2 R2024.JUN:
 - Bundesbank (National Service Desk) will contact relevant customers for re-testing and request reporting of the test results
- •There will be no dedicated query to carry out the regression tests
